We are seeking your assistance. We would like you to fill in an online survey that is part of the evaluation of *Play.sport*. The information you share is important as it will help to develop and strengthen *Play.sport*. If you also filled in a survey last year – thank you very much.

What is this evaluation about?	Sport NZ has contracted NZCER to provide evaluation services for <i>Play.sport</i> during 2016-2019. The initial focus of the evaluation is about working with you and other stakeholders to develop <i>Play.sport</i> approaches, it is not about evaluating your teaching or school practice .
What am I being asked to do, and why?	We are inviting you to take part in a confidential online survey about how <i>Play.sport</i> is developing at your school. The questions ask about the <i>Play.sport</i> PLD and support you have access to, if this is helping you to plan and teach PE, and your ideas for future support.
How long will the survey take and who is it for?	The survey should take about 5 to 10 minutes and only contains 12 key questions. The survey is for teachers and school leaders at primary and intermediate schools.
Is it confidential, and do I have to take part?	The survey is confidential. No individual's names, or the names of schools, will be used in any reports or discussions. As part of the agreement to participate in <i>Play.sport</i> there is a commitment from each school to contribute to the <i>Play.sport</i> evaluation. Participation in the <i>Play.sport</i> evaluation activities is voluntary, but we strongly encourage you to take part.
How will the findings be used?	Findings will be discussed and reported to Sport NZ, and will be used as a source of information to develop <i>Play.sport</i> , as well as helping us decide which schools to visit later in the year.
What will happen to the data?	The data will be stored on a secure server and destroyed 3 years after the evaluation finishes.
What else is involved in the evaluation?	Later in the year we will be visiting some schools to talk with teachers and school leaders about their experiences of <i>Play.sport</i> . We will also be talking with some of the <i>Play.sport</i> workforce who are supporting schools, and people who manage community sport connections.
