Te kōwhiri i te aromatawai tika Choosing the right assessment

You will get the most relevant and accurate information of what ākonga know, understand, and can do when you choose an assessment that matches their capabilities. Use your professional judgement to consider differentiating the assessments for ākonga. Alternatively, the computer adaptive assessment (CAT) creates a personalised assessment for ākonga.

Te pānui i ngā aromatawai ki ngā ākonga Reading the assessments to ākonga

PAT tests 1A, 1 and 2 have an audio option. Ākonga can click on this symbol  to have the question read to them. For other PATs, you are welcome to **read** questions to any ākonga having difficulty during the assessment. However, avoid explaining what the questions mean.

Te wā Timing

Ākonga are expected to work independently and have 45 minutes to complete the questions. You may make the decision to extend the time allowance, however, results will not be comparable with the normative information.
