

Addendum: The Māori Language in Northwestern Bay of Islands, CR 130.

Correction to the figures in the last sentence of the first paragraph of the report, pg.1. It should read:

“They have a combined population of 247, 242 of whom were of Māori descent, mostly with Ngapuhi as their main iwi.”

Correction to the table: Knowledge of Spoken Māori in Northwest Bay of Islands (1975); pg. 2.

The overall percentages in the last column labelled Oromahoe, Pakaraka, Waimate N, should read:

Fluent speakers: 45% (correct)

Understand easily: 60%

Limited understanding: 25%

No Knowledge: 14%
