

Margaret May Blackwell Travel Fellowship

Instructions for applicants

Application close Friday 3 April 2020.

Follow these instructions to apply for the fellowship.

The application is made up of five elements, outlined below.

1. A covering email or letter with personal information

Your covering email or letter should include the following information about yourself:

- Name
- Job
- Name/s of the early childhood or other organisations to which you belong
- Employer
- Contact address (work preferred)
- Contact phone number
- An instance in your early childhood practice where you feel you made a difference

2. A statement about how you would use the fellowship

Your statement should cover these points:

- Your objectives for the fellowship
- Your ability to benefit from the fellowship
- Your capacity to transmit and disseminate the knowledge that you gain.
- A draft proposed travel itinerary (approximate costing only)

3. A brief curriculum vitae

Your curriculum vitae should include any academic study or professional development you have completed or are pursuing.

4. A reference

Your referee should follow the instructions on the Blackwell Referee Form available on the NZCER website [here](#). You may also like to send them the information sheet.

Your referee may choose to send the reference directly to us, or to copy to you.

5. A printed and signed copy of the following agreement

Agreement to conditions of the Margaret May Blackwell Fellowship

If I receive the fellowship, I will endeavour to complete the funded travel by 31 December 2020.

As a condition of acceptance of the fellowship I will provide the Margaret May Blackwell bequest trust with a report of the study undertaken within three months of completion of the award.

I am prepared to engage in other forms of dissemination of information including: an interview about my experience for publication purposes, speaking engagements, reporting to media, attending meetings, as appropriate.
